Members Code of Conduct

Purpose

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to set out standards of behaviour expected of all club members. In agreeing to be part of the Club, each member will certify that they will adhere to these codes at all times.

Members must:

Behave with honesty and integrity

Act with due care and diligence

Treat everyone with respect and courtesy and without harassment

Comply with all applicable Australian laws

Use the Club's property and money efficiently, carefully and honestly with due authorisation and without misapplication and/or misappropriation

Comply with any lawful or reasonable direction given by a person with the authority to give that direction

Maintain appropriate confidentiality in relation to dealings requiring it

Disclose, and take steps to avoid, any conflicts of interest whether real or apparent

Behave in a way that upholds the core values, integrity and reputation of the Club and its members

Not provide false or misleading information

Breaches of the Code of Conduct may relate to specific breaches of policies and procedures and may attract disciplinary action, which may include investigation, removal of privileges or access, repayment of monies, referral to Police in the case of unlawful behaviour and termination of membership
