

LFNC Excursion Sunday 30th March 2025

Leader: Dr Ian Thomas – Palaeoecologist and knowledgeable geologist

“This excursion will visit a number of accessible places of geological/ecological/historical interest along the Tamar/Kanamaluka Valley.

Thinking about formation processes of landforms along the route will enable members to conceive of the valley not as a place with a simple single history, but instead, as a place with a long complex and at times violent history.

Members should meet at the **Low Head Lighthouse carpark** (not the Pilot Station) **at 10 am** on the 30th. March.

The excursion will **finish by 2pm** in the public car park **at Tamar Marine**, just off the West Tamar Road. Lunch will probably take place at the Supply River historical site where the Supply River enters the Tamar/Kanamaluka proper.”
